


I Julia Curtis being of sound mind and memory do make and constitute this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills by me made, I give and bequeath to Rebecca Brown and dectha Howe all my wearing apparel household and kitchen furniture to be equally divided between them, I give and bequeath unto the said Rebecca Brown a part of lot in the town of Newbern known in the plan of said town by the number two hundred and twenty five beginning on Fleet Street at Street Crossbees corner and running Westwardly with said Crossbees line to the back of the lot then Southwardly parallel to Fleet Street thirty feet thence Eastward parallel to said Crossbees line to Fleet Street thence with Fleet Street to the beginning to the said Rebecca Brown her and heirs and assigns forever, the residue of my property both real and personal I give and bequeath to my beloved brother John Curtis his heirs and assigns forever, In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 29<sup>th</sup> May 1838
